<u>O R D E R</u>

On July 12, 1996, having been advised by the parties that negotiations were ongoing, the Commission entered its Order cancelling the scheduled hearing and holding this matter in abeyance pending the outcome of the parties' negotiations concerning an alternative site for the proposed cellular facility. Subsequently, on August 1, 1996, Kentucky CGSA, Inc. ("Kentucky CGSA") filed a statement that the proposed alternative site is no longer under consideration due to potential environmental problems. Consequently, Kentucky CGSA requests that a hearing on the application be scheduled as soon as possible.

The Commission being sufficiently advised, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A hearing on the proposed cell site is scheduled for September 27, 1996, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 2 of the Commission's offices at 677 Comanche Trail, Frankfort, Kentucky. 2. Kentucky CGSA shall appear at the hearing and be prepared to present testimony on the engineering design, location, and construction of the proposed cell site, the safety issues relating to the operation of the cell site, and all other issues raised by the intervenors.

3. Any interested person shall have the opportunity to present testimony or comment on any aspect of the proposed cell site.

4. Pursuant to KRS 100.324, a copy of this Order is being sent to the Jefferson County Planning Commission for the purpose of notification that the above-scheduled hearing may affect locations or relocations of service facilities within the planning unit's jurisdiction.
