DEAR MR. MILLS,

IT HAS BEEN BROUGHT TO MY ATTENTION THAT A PROPOSAL IS PENDING CONCERNING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A **CELLULAR TOWER** IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF ST. ATHANASIUS SCHOOL. AS PRINCIPAL OF ST. ATHANASIUS SCHOOL, I STRONGLY OPPOSE THE INSTALLATION OF SUCH A TOWER BECAUSE OF ITS PROXIMITY TO THE SCHOOL AS WELL AS THE PROXIMITY TO THE RESIDENTIAL AREA IN THE MANY SUBDIVISIONS LOCATED OFF OF OUTER LOOP.

I AM EXTREMELY CONCERNED THAT THE PARENTS OF STUDENTS ATTENDING ST. ATHANASIUS HAVE NOT BEEN NOTIFIED ABOUT THIS PROPOSED STRUCTURE.

AS PRINCIPAL OF THE SCHOOL, I URGE YOU TO DENY THE INSTALLATION OF SUCH A STRUCTURE OR AT LEAST HAVE A PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE ISSUE SO THAT THE PEOPLE BEING AFFECTED BY THIS MAY HAVE SOME VOICE IN THE DECISION.
