O R D E R

On May 21, 1996, Frances Turner Smith filed a formal complaint with the Commission against Sandy Valley Water District ("Sandy Valley") for lack of city water due to low pressure. On June 17, 1996, Sandy Valley filed an answer to this complaint stating that it had contacted an engineering firm to install a pump that should restore water pressure to Ms. Smith. It appearing to the Commission that Sandy Valley is making efforts to remedy Ms. Smith's situation, and being otherwise sufficiently advised HEREBY ORDERS that this case is dismissed, without prejudice, and Ms. Smith may petition the Commission to reopen this case if Sandy Valley has not remedied the situation within 90 days of the date of this Order.
