WirelessCo., L.P., doing business in Kentucky as Sprint Spectrum, has applied to the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") of Kentucky for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a new Public Communications Services ("PCS") facility to provide personal wireless telephone and data services. A large percentage of Sprint Spectrum's proposed new facilities will be located on existing structures (ie., rooftops and water tanks). Unfortunately, no such appropriate and available structure exists in this area. Therefore, the proposed new facility will include a monopole, with attached antennas extending upward for a total height of 150', and an equipment shelter to be located at 7331 Intermodal Drive, Louisville, Kentucky. A map showing the location of the proposed new PCS facility is enclosed. This notice is being sent to you because you own property or reside within a 500' radius of the proposed monopole.

The Commission invites your comments regarding the proposed construction. You also have the right to intervene in this matter. Your initial communication to the Commission must be received by the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter as shown above.
