ORDER

On July 8, 1996, U.S. 60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties ("U.S. 60") applied to the Commission for an adjustment of rates effective August 20, 1996. On July 23, 1996, the Commission found U.S. 60's application deficient and refused to accept it. It directed U.S. 60 to file certain information to correct these filing deficiencies. U.S. 60 corrected these deficiencies on July 29, 1996 but continued to use August 20, 1996 as the effective date of its proposed tariff. As a tariff revision may only become effective upon 30-days' notice to the Commission, the correct effective date of the proposed tariff is August 28, 1996.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- The proposed rates are hereby suspended for 5 months from August 28,
 1996 up to and including January 27, 1997.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
