ORDER

On July 24, 1996, the Commission received a letter from Sam Goldstein protesting the construction of a personal communication services facility. Mr. Goldstein's letter did not contain a case number and, in attempting to place Mr. Goldstein's letter in the proper case record, the Commission, through inadvertence, placed Mr. Goldstein's letter in Case No. 96-322. By Order dated July 30, 1996 in Case No. 96-322, the Commission ordered WirelessCo, L.P. ("WirelessCo") to respond to Mr. Goldstein's concerns. However, it now appears that Mr. Goldstein was in actuality protesting the construction of the facility in Case No. 96-241.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, nunc pro tunc, that:

- 1. Mr. Goldstein's letter, filed July 24, 1996, shall be removed from the record of Case No. 96-322 and shall be placed in the record of Case No. 96-241.
 - WirelessCo shall respond to Mr. Goldstein's concerns in Case No. 96-241.
