O R D E R


On September 24, 1996, Communication Telesystems International ("Communication Telesystems") filed a motion to withdraw its application for authority to provide intrastate, long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. In support of its motion, Communication Telesystems states that it intends to seek authority to operate pursuant to the Commission's decision in Administrative Case No. 359.¹ Based on the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause to allow the application to be withdrawn.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Communication Telesystem's motion to withdraw its application is granted and this case is dismissed without prejudice.
