It has recently come to my attention that there was a public notice issued on this case on July 15, 1996. Even though this proposed project directly affects my property I was never notified of the opportunity to comment. The construction of the tower does not affect my property but construction of the access road does as it runs through my property on a right-of-way. I reviewed the project files at the Public Service Commission office on September 24, 1996 and found that GTE Mobilenet of Kentucky plans on rerouting the access road through my property. They have no right to do this as the right-of-way through my property is well defined in my deed and cannot be deviated from without my consent. If they want to reroute the access road GTE Mobilenet has ever contacted me to discuss this. However, no representative of GTE Mobilenet has ever contacted me in person or in writing.

Therefore, I request that this case be reviewed by your office and that any permits be denied until this concern can be adequately addressed. I would also like to request that I be a party of record and that the public comment period be reopened since I was never notified. If needed, I will get my attorney involved with this issue.
