## ORDER

By application received July 23, 1996, Trimble County Water District No. 1 ("Trimble Water") requested a deviation from Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(4), which requires that each utility shall provide water storage to ensure a minimum of one day's supply of its average daily water usage. Trimble Water states that its average daily water usage in April 1996, including unaccounted-for water, was approximately 271,000 gallons, and its current water storage capacity is 263,000 gallons.

The Commission, having reviewed the application and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Trimble Water is not in compliance with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(4).
- 2. Because of the time needed to plan, finance, and implement a program to construct water storage facilities, Trimble Water should be given until January 1, 2002 to comply with 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(4).

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Trimble Water is hereby given until January 1, 2002 to comply with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:066, Section 4(4).

2. Trimble Water shall take all necessary actions to bring its water storage facilities into compliance with Commission regulations prior to January 1, 2002.
