O R D E R

This matter arising upon the motion of Caldwell R. Willig filed August 12, 1996 for full intervention, and it appearing to the Commission that Mr. Willig has a special interest which is not otherwise adequately represented, and that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, Mr. Willig's motion to intervene should be granted. Mr. Willig also requests that a hearing should be set in this matter. However, since other interested persons may yet wish to file motions to intervene, the Commission will hold in abeyance Mr. Willig's motion for a hearing and will address it at the appropriate time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The motion of Caldwell R. Willig to intervene is granted.
2. Mr. Willig shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
3. Should Mr. Willig file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, he shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.

4. Mr. Willig's motion for a hearing shall be held in abeyance until further Order of the Commission.
