O R D E R

On September 20, 1996, the Commission issued an Order opening an investigation into the jurisdictional status of Pine Tree Mobile Home Court. A written response was filed by Joseph Crutcher, owner of Pine Tree Mobile Court, on October 4, 1996. While a hearing in this matter is presently scheduled for November 7, 1996, the Commission requires additional information at the present time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Joseph Crutcher shall file the original and five copies of the following information with the Commission no later than seven days from the date of this Order.

1. Does Joseph Crutcher, as owner of the Pine Tree Mobile Home Court, provide sewer service to anyone other than residents of Pine Tree Mobile Home Court? If so, how many?

2. Does Joseph Crutcher, as owner of the Pine Tree Mobile Home Court, provide water service to anyone other than residents of Pine Tree Mobile Home Court? If so, how many?
