ORDER

On September 17, 1996, Todd County Water District ("Todd Water") applied to the Commission for authority to increase its charge for a one-inch meter connection from \$500 to \$1,000. Todd Water proposed an effective date of December 1, 1996.

After reviewing the proposed tariff, the Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariff is suspended for five months from December 1, 1996 up to and including April 30, 1997.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
