<u>ORDER</u>

On June 20, 1997, the above utility was ordered, by this Commission, to show cause why it should not be penalized for having failed to comply with the applicable sections of KRS Chapter 278 for failure to file its Gross Revenue Report.

By Order of the Commission dated October 24, 1997, the utility was assessed a penalty of \$250, ordered to pay same within 20 days of the date of the Order, and to file its Gross Revenue Report.

It appears, based upon Commission records, that Hebron Communications Corporation did not commence operations in Kentucky until January 2, 1997 and, based upon the law, would not be required to file the subject report until after the end of calendar year 1997.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, to be entered <u>nunc</u> <u>pro</u> <u>tunc</u>, that the Order of this Commission issued under date of October 24, 1997 is hereby vacated and set aside.
