<u>ORDER</u>

Hardin County Water District No. 1 ("Hardin District") has moved for approval of certain modifications to its original plan of construction for which the Commission issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity on April 18, 1997.¹ These modifications include: an increase in labor costs to ensure Hardin District's compliance with KRS Chapter 337, the construction of an underground trench drainage system, and minor modifications to the proposed structure's interior and exterior features. Having considered the motions and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the proposed modifications should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Hardin District's motions for approval of modifications are granted.

The modifications which are set forth in Hardin District's letters of April 23,
1997 and April 25, 1997 are approved.
