GTE Mobilnet Incorporated ("GTE Mobilnet") has moved the Commission to dismiss its application for authority to construct a personal communications service facility off Winters Lane near Cold Spring, in Campbell County, Kentucky.

As grounds for its motion, GTE Mobilnet states that subsequent to the filing of this application its Radio Frequency Engineers conducted an additional evaluation of the proposed facility and determined that the coverage capability of this site is not suitable. Based on the motion and being advised, the Commission finds good cause exists to dismiss this application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that GTE Mobilnet's motion is granted and this application is dismissed.
