Several residents in our community recently received a letter concerning the above-referenced case and brought it to the attention of the Lewisburg Neighborhood Association, it appears the proposed tower is in our neighborhood.

At the Lewisburg Neighborhood Association meeting held on May 14, 1997, the following resolution was passed:

A motion was made by Jerry Stickley in response to a letter from Sitlinger, McGlincy, Steiner, Theiler & Karem, Attorneys at Law, located at 3450 National City Tower, 101 S. Fifth Street in Louisville, Kentucky, to express opposition by the Lewisburg Neighborhood Association to the construction and operation of a 120-foot tower to provide cellular radio telecommunications service proposed for Lewisburg. Seconded by Mary Jane Klare, motion passed unanimously.

Concerns expressed by the residents included:

- Hillside stability
- Compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act since Lewisburg is a National Register Historic District
- Health and safety issue
- Possibilities of interruption of local communications
- Aesthetics
