O R D E R

On April 23, 1997, a complaint was filed on behalf of Leisure Creek Townhouse Association by Cathy L. Kennedy which named Kentucky-American Water Company as the defendant. Ms. Kennedy was notified by letter dated April 28, 1997, that pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(2):

Complaints by corporations or associations, or any other organization having the right to file a complaint, must be signed by its attorney and show his post office address.

Furthermore, the letter informed Ms. Kennedy that such representation before an administrative agency is considered the practice of law and must be performed by a licensed attorney. See Kentucky Bar Ass'n v. Henry Vogt Machine Co., Ky., 416 S.W.2d 727 (1967).


The letter gave Ms. Kennedy 20 days in which to have Leisure Creek Townhouse Association's complaint properly refiled in compliance with 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 3

and 12. If the complaint was not refiled within this time period, the complaint would be dismissed. As the complaint has not been refiled, nor have there been any requests for additional time in which to refile the complaint, it should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the complaint of Leisure Creek Townhouse Association against Kentucky-American Water Company is dismissed, without prejudice.
