O R D E R

On March 26, 1997, Kentucky Power Company, d/b/a American Electric Power, filed a proposed special contract with INCO Alloys International, Inc. to furnish electric energy delivered at alternating current at approximately 69 kV, 3 wire, three phase.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed contract.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The proposed contract is suspended for five months from April 25, 1997 up to and including September 24, 1997.
2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
