ORDER

Henderson Union Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Henderson Union") has moved for relief from the Commission's Order of May 7, 1997. In support of its motion, Henderson Union states that the Order seeks information which is pertinent only for the review of an application for general rate adjustment. Henderson Union further states that it will not apply for a general adjustment of its rates, but will request only the authority to pass any rate reductions which it receives from its wholesale power supplier to its ratepayers.

Having considered the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Henderson Union's Motion for Relief is granted.
- 2. Henderson Union is released from any obligation to respond to the Commission's Order of May 7, 1997.
