Dear Sir:

Please be advised that I need to know and understand what my rights are as an affected property owner. Please send to me the regulation or statute concerning the construction of a cell facility to provide cellular radio telecommunication service.

I have been informed by the surveyor for West Virginia Cellular Telephone Corp. that no construction can be made within the 500' radius of the tower. I have several building lots located within this radius. If I am not permitted to construct homes in this area, then the value of my real estate will be greatly diminished. Should my property be devaluated, then I must be compensated for the value of my property.

Be advised that I am opposed to this project if I am adversely affected. If necessary, I will seek whatever relief is available to me through the courts.

Please advise me as soon as possible concerning the regulation for this project.




Dear Ms. Thompson:

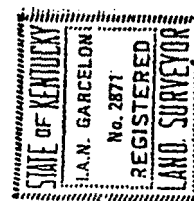

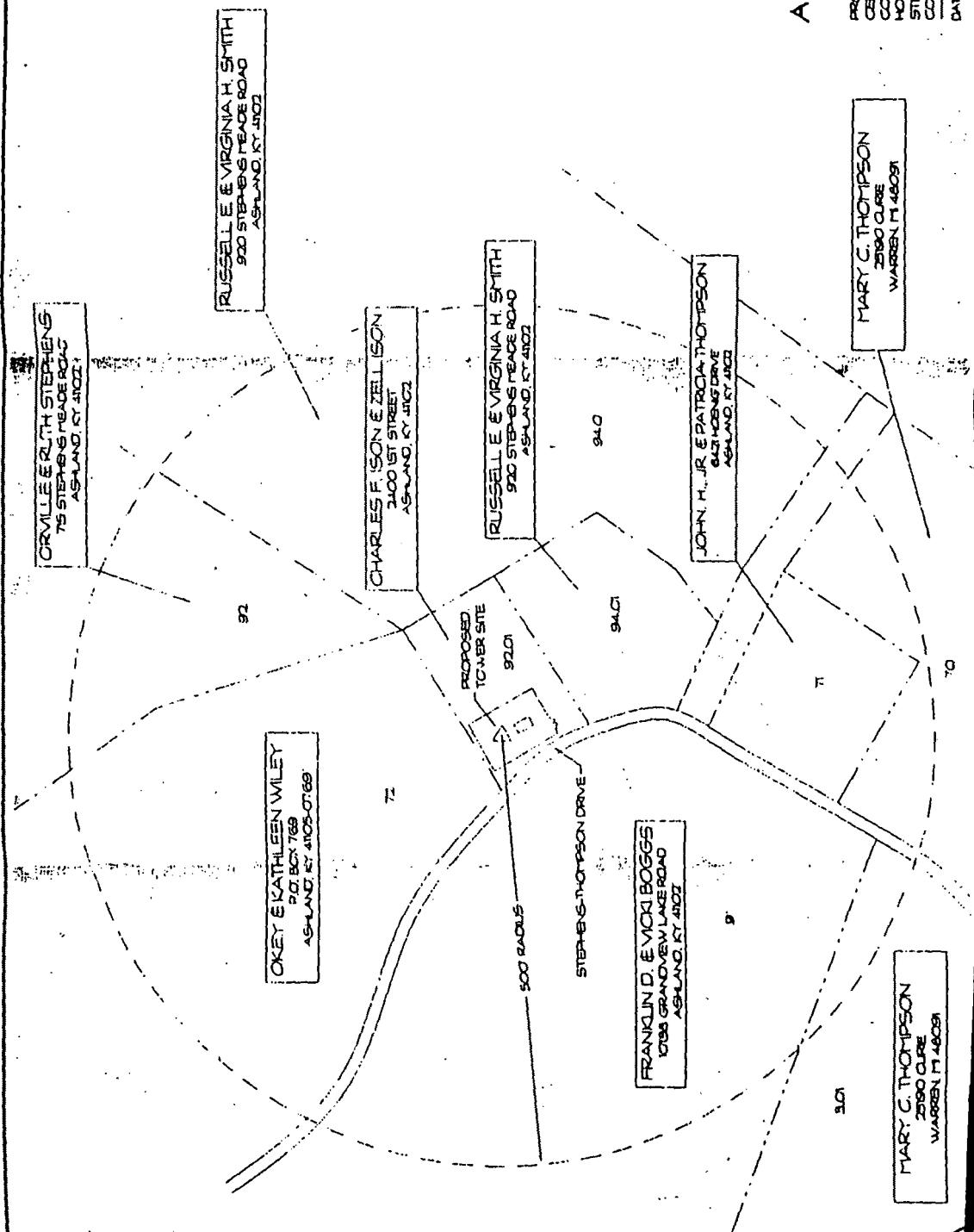

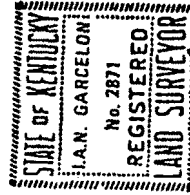
Therefore, John and Patricia Thompson would respectfully request that they be allowed to intervene in this matter so that they may contest the construction of the proposed tower.

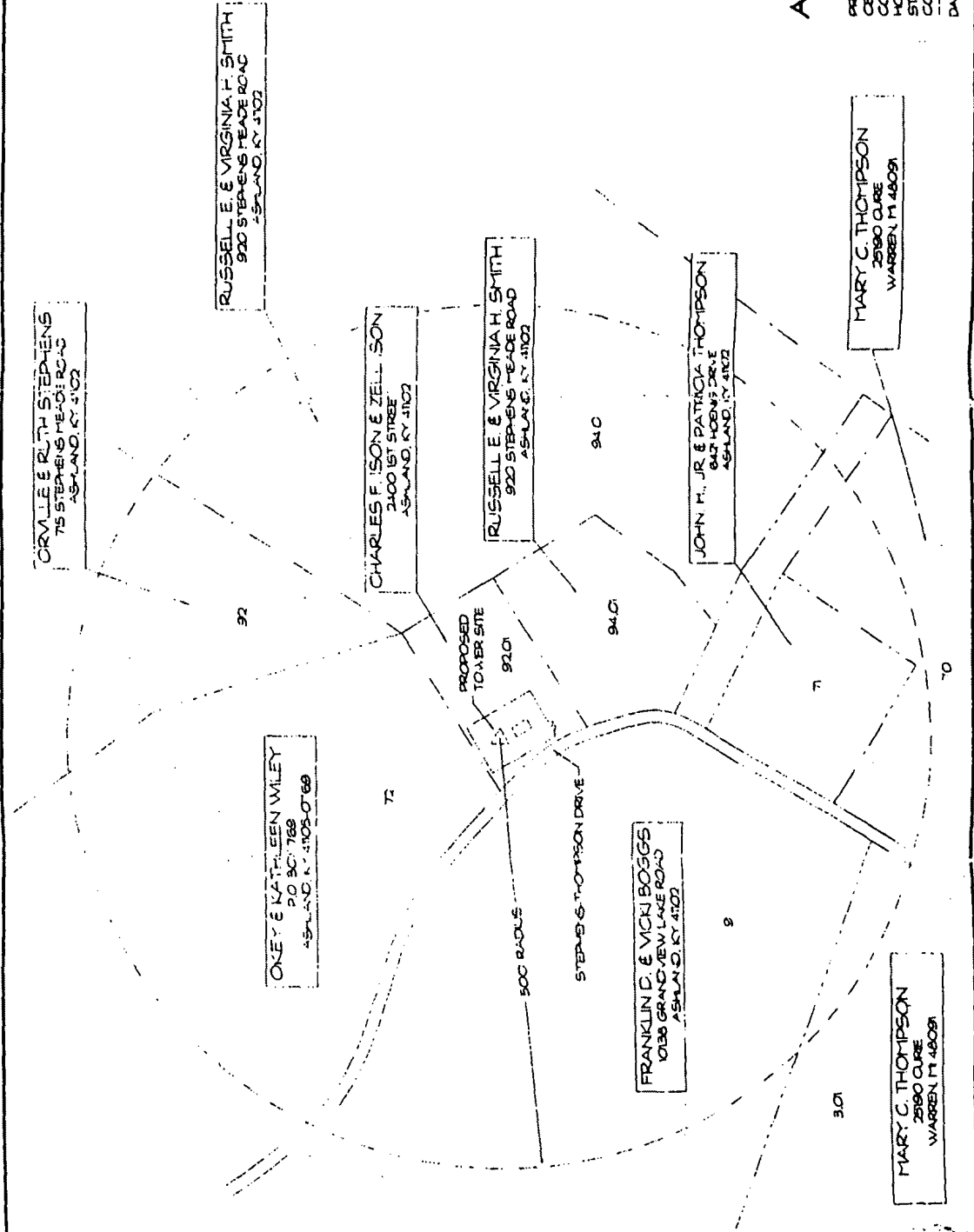


