<u>ORDER</u>

1. The motion of Winchester Municipal Utilities Commission and the City of Winchester, Kentucky (collectively referred to as "Winchester") for full intervention is granted.

2. Winchester shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.

3. The procedural schedule listed in Appendix A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed.

4. All requests for information and responses thereto shall be appropriately indexed. All responses shall include the name of the witness who will be responsible for

responding to the questions related to the information provided, with copies to all parties of record and 10 copies to the Commission.

5. Boonesboro Water Association, Inc. ("Boonesboro") and Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky-American") shall give notice of the hearing in accordance with the provisions set out in 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5). At the time publication is requested, the Applicant shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

6. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of compelling reasons.

7. Should Winchester file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, it shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.

8. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.

<u>O R D E R</u>

On July 18, 1997, Boonesboro Water Association and Kentucky-American Water Company ("Applicants") applied to the Commission for authority to transfer the ownership of the assets of Boonesboro to Kentucky-American. In the filing, Applicants requested permission to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 11, which requires the submission of an adoption notice. Kentucky-American seeks to apply its existing rates to Boonesboro's water customers if the transfer is approved. Kentucky-American intends to adopt Boonesboro's sewer rates as its own following the transfer.

Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately Applicants' filing. Therefore, the request for permission to deviate from the above-cited regulation regarding the rates for water service should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicants' request for permission to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 11, is hereby granted.
