<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED that Boone County Water District ("Boone District") shall file the original and 8 copies of the following information with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order, with a copy to all parties of record. Each copy of the information requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure its legibility. Where requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this Order. When applicable, the requested information should be provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations, separately.

1. Refer to Boone District's Application, Exhibit 2 at 2 ("Statement of Contributions and Estimated Final Cost"). In this exhibit, Boone District states that "the Fiscal Court will contribute One Thousand Fifty Three Dollars (\$1,053.00) per assessed

lot." In determining the "Total Fiscal Court Contribution," Boone District uses a contribution rate of \$1,063 per assessed lot. What is Boone County Fiscal Court's contribution rate for the proposed project?

2. Refer to Boone District's Application, Exhibit 2 at 2 ("Statement of Contributions and Estimated Final Cost"). In estimating its contribution towards the construction project, Boone District did not calculate the "per foot cost" for the proposed project based upon the total project cost of \$1,120,910.

a. Why did Boone District use this method?

b. How is this method consistent with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11?

3. Refer to Boone District's Application, Exhibit 2 at 2 ("Statement of Contributions and Estimated Final Cost"). The contribution of Boone Fiscal Court is based upon the assumption that 216 lots will be assessed. The estimated assessment assumes a lower number of lots subject to assessment. Why is this methodology used? Why was the estimated assessment not based upon 216 lots?
