WE WRITE TO PROTEST THE PROPOSED
LOCATION OF THE SUBJECT TOWER IN
A PEACEFUL RURAL COMMUNITY. WE
KNOW THE TOWER WILL BE UNSIGHTLY
AND BELIEVE THE BLINKING LIGHTS
WILL BE A CONTINUAL DISTRACTION.

WE ALSO HAVE THE FOLLOWING
CONCERNS:

1. THERE IS NO SCALE OR NORTH ARROW
ON THE MAP FURNISHED.
2. OWNER LISTING WITHIN THE 500 FT.
RADIUS ARE INCOMPLETE.

3. DOES THE 500 FT. RADIUS CENTER ON THE TOWER ITSELF, OR SHOULD THERE BE SEVERAL CONNECTING RADIi CENTERED ON THE REQUIRED ANCHORS? WE NOTE THAT THE ANCHORS ARE GENERALLY A REQUIREMENT.
4. THE SITE CHOSEN IS ON A WASTE AREA FOR EXCESS MATERIAL FROM THE CONSTRUCTION OF U.S. 127.
5. THE SITE WAS NOT COMPACTED OR IN ANY OTHER WAY PREPARED TO SERVE AS A FOUNDATION.
6. HAS AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STUDY BEEN DONE ON THIS SITE?
7. WHAT HAPPENS TO THE TOWER WHEN ADVANCING TECHNOLOGY RENDERS IT OBSOLETE?
8. WILL THE TOWER SERVE ONLY A PUBLIC NEED, OR WILL ADDITIONAL HEIGHT BE ADDED AS PURELY COMMERCIAL?

9. SHOULD A TAX-EXEMPT FACILITY
LIKE THE CHURCH OF THE OPEN
BIBLE BE INVOLVED IN SUCH A
COMMERCIAL VENTURE?

10. SUCH A TOWER MUST HAVE A
NEGATIVE EFFECT ON SURROUNDING
PROPERTY VALUES.

11. THE PROPOSED LOCATION IS IN THE
FLIGHT PATH USED BY THE NATIONAL
GUARD HELICOPTERS FROM FRANKFORT.

PLEASE GIVE PROPER CONSIDERATIONS
TO THESE CONCERNS
