<u>ORDER</u>

On August 22, 1997, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and Powertel, Inc. ("Powertel") submitted to the Commission their negotiated agreement for collocation. The agreement was negotiated pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("1996 Act"), 47 U.S.C. Section 252(e). Section 252(e) of the 1996 Act requires the parties to a collocation agreement adopted by negotiation to submit the agreement for approval to the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the agreement and finds that no portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement. The Commission also finds that the implementation of this agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

Powertel must comply with all relevant Commission mandates for serving in this Commonwealth.

The Commission, having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and Powertel for collocation is approved.
