IT IS ORDERED that Kentucky-Ohio Gas Acquisition Corporation (KOG) shall file with the Commission the original and 4 copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due no later than ten (10) days from the date of this Order. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible.

1. Refer to Schedule II, Expected Gas Cost Adjustment of the amended application. Provide contracts or other documentation that support the \$3.33 rate charged by E Prime and the \$1.90 rate charged by KOG.

2. KOG has not made a Gas Cost Adjustment (GCA) filing with the Commission since September 1998. Provide a detailed explanation for KOG s not

making a GCA filing between September 1998 and the filing of its current GCA application.

3. Refer to the cover letter dated September 30, 1999 and Schedule IV of both the original and amended applications which indicate that KOG charged its customers an expected gas cost of \$2.72 rather than the \$2.06 approved by the Commission in Case No. 91-138-K. Provide an explanation of what KOG actually charged its customers and why the incorrect rate was used.
