O R D E R

On September 1, 1999, the Commission entered an Order directing SprintCom, Inc. ("SprintCom") to prefile testimony in response to the issues discussed in the body of the Order, with a copy to all parties of record. The testimony was due 60 days from the date of the Order. The Order further set a hearing on the issues for November 19, 1999. SprintCom failed to file the testimony and at the hearing advised the Commission that it was having difficulty getting the witnesses to cooperate. Due to the difficulties that SprintCom has experienced, an additional 90 days from the hearing date should be allowed to enable it to prefile its testimony.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. On or before 90 days from November 19, 1999, SprintCom shall prefile the direct testimony previously ordered on September 1, 1999.
2. If SprintCom finds it is unable to obtain all or any part of the prefiled testimony, it shall so advise the Commission in writing, describing the difficulties it has encountered.

3. The hearing in this matter shall be continued generally pending compliance with this Order.
