ORDER

On June 4, 1998, Webster County Water District ("Webster County") filed a petition with the Commission for a certificate to construct, for approval of financing of plant facilities, and for a rate increase. On March 5, 1999, an Order was entered containing a Staff report and recommendations for the rate schedule for Webster County. Webster County has requested an informal conference to address several issues contained in the Staff report. The Commission finds that an informal conference should be held between the Commission Staff, the Attorney General, and Webster County to discuss those issues.
