O R D E R

On May 14, 1999, Crown Communication, Inc. ("Crown") filed a motion requesting the Commission to allow it to amend its engineering drawings filed prior to the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity in this case. Attached to the motion is an exhibit demonstrating the proposed change in the engineering design, demonstrating that the new plans are in conformity with nationally recognized building standards. The plans also demonstrate that the tower will be constructed within the height limitations specified by the Commission's final order in this case. Crown further states that the co-applicant of Crown in this case consents to the new plans.

The Commission having been sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Crown's motion to amend its engineering drawings filed in this action is granted.
2. This case is reopened for the sole purpose of incorporating into the record the motion of Crown, with supporting documentation, and this Order.

3. The record in this case, modified as described herein, is hereby closed.
