O R D E R

On March 23, 1999, Crown Communication, Inc., Tritel Communications, Inc. and Tritel Finance, Inc. (hereinafter "Applicants") requested a waiver of the regulation, 807 KAR 5:063, Section 1(1)(d) and (j), which requires Applicants to file boring logs, foundation design recommendations, and tower foundation design plans. Applicants request that the Commission permit these items to be filed after a certificate of public convenience and necessity has been granted.

In support of their motion, Applicants state that the site for the proposed construction of the facility is currently occupied by a large building which will not be demolished unless and until the Commission approves the proposed construction site. If approval is granted, then the soil and rock borings will be undertaken.

The Commission finds that, good cause having been shown, Applicants should be granted relief from the requirement of filing boring logs, foundation design

recommendations, and tower foundation design plans at this time. Upon approval of the site proposed by Applicants, the filings waived herein shall be provided to the Commission for review prior to Applicants' beginning construction of the wireless communications facility.
