O R D E R

On March 23, 1999, Crown Communication Inc., Tritel Communications, Inc., and Tritel Finance, Inc. ("Applicants") filed a uniform application for construction of a wireless communications facility in Woodford County, Kentucky. On May 12, 1999, the Commission granted full intervention to R.C. Manning; Gainsborough Farm; Mr. and Mrs. Hampton H. Henton; Allen E. Paulson d/b/a Brookside Farm; Mr. and Mrs. Duane Rolando; Joseph Seitz, and Fred Seitz. On May 21, 1999, the Commission granted full intervention to Tom Thornbury; Craig F. Chamberlin; Teri Faragher; Jeff Alexander, and E.R. Moody.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A public hearing is scheduled for August 17, 1999, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky.

2. On or before August 4, 1999, Applicants must prefile with the Commission all direct testimony, including testimony on the engineering design, location, and construction of the proposed cell site and the jurisdictional safety issues relating to the cell site.
