O R D E R

On May 6, 1999, SprintCom, Inc. (SprintCom) filed an application with the Commission requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a cellular facility at 9350 Dixie Highway, Corinth, Grant County, Kentucky.

SprintCom having moved for a hearing in this matter and the Intervenors having stated their intent to appear at the hearing in opposition, the Commission scheduled a hearing on the proposed cellular facility for August 24, 1999, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 2 of the Commission s offices at 677 Comanche Trail, Frankfort, Kentucky. On August 16, 1999, SprintCom filed a motion to reschedule the hearing due to a conflict in scheduling. The Commission, having considered the motion and good cause having been shown, hereby finds that the motion should be granted.

The Commission further finds that the proposed site is to be located in Grant County, Kentucky and has been approved by the Grant County Planning Commission. Accordingly, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063, the character of the general area concerned and

the likely effects of the installation on nearby land uses and values shall not be taken into consideration by the Commission. Testimony received by the Commission shall, therefore, be limited to the areas of service and safety.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The hearing scheduled for August 24, 1999, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 2 of the Commission's offices at 677 Comanche Trail, Frankfort, Kentucky is rescheduled to September 14, 1999, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky.

2. SprintCom shall appear at the hearing and be prepared to present testimony on the engineering design, location and construction for the proposed cell site, as well as the safety issues relating to the cell site.

3. The intervenors shall have the opportunity to present testimony or comment on any aspect of the safety and service of the proposed tower.

4. Prefiled testimony, if any, shall be filed by August 8, 1999.

5. Neither opening statements nor witnesses' summaries of prefiled direct testimony will be permitted.

6. Pursuant to KRS 100.324, a copy of this Order is being sent to the Grant County Planning Commission for the purpose of notification that the above-scheduled hearing may affect locations or relocations of service facilities within the planning unit's jurisdiction.
