On May 6, 1999, SprintCom, Inc., (SprintCom) filed an application with the Commission requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a cellular facility at 9350 Dixie Highway, Corinth, Grant County, Kentucky.

SprintCom having moved for a hearing in this matter, the Commission has scheduled a hearing on the proposed cellular facility for August 24, 1999, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 2 of the Commission s offices at 677 Comanche Trail, Frankfort, Kentucky. If a party wishes to appear at the hearing in opposition to the proposed facility he should, within 10 days of the date of this Order, so notify the Commission. If no statement of intent to appear at the hearing and present evidence against the proposed facility is received by the Commission, the hearing will be cancelled and this matter submitted to the Commission for a decision based on the record.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. A hearing on the proposed cell site is scheduled for August 24, 1999, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 2 of the Commission's offices at 677 Comanche Trail, Frankfort, Kentucky.

2. SprintCom shall appear at the hearing and be prepared to present testimony on the engineering design, location and construction for the proposed cell site, as well as the safety issues relating to the cell site.

3. Any interested person shall have the opportunity to present testimony or comment on any aspect of the proposed cell site.

4. Prefiled testimony, if any, shall be filed by August 17, 1999.

5. Neither opening statements nor witnesses summaries of prefiled direct testimony will be permitted.

6. Any party who wishes to appear at the hearing in opposition to the proposed site shall file a statement to that effect within 10 days of the date of this Order.

7. If the Commission does not receive, within 10 days of the date of this Order, a statement expressing a party s intent to appear in opposition to the proposed cell site, the hearing shall be cancelled and the matter shall be submitted to the Commission for a decision on the record.
