## <u>ORDER</u>

On September 7, 1999, the Intervenors filed a motion to reschedule the hearing due to a conflict in scheduling. The Commission, having considered the motion and good cause having been shown, hereby finds that the motion should be granted.

The Commission further finds that the proposed site is to be located in Grant County, Kentucky and has been approved by the Grant County Planning Commission. Accordingly, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063, the character of the general area concerned and the likely effects of the installation on nearby land uses and values shall not be taken into consideration by the Commission. Testimony received by the Commission shall, therefore, be limited to the areas of service and safety.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The hearing scheduled for September 14, 1999 at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky is rescheduled to October 15, 1999, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time.

2. SprintCom shall appear at the hearing and be prepared to present testimony on the engineering design, location and construction for the proposed cell site, as well as the safety issues relating to the cell site.

3. The Intervenors shall have the opportunity to present testimony or comment on any aspect of the safety and service of the proposed tower.

4. Prefiled testimony, if any, shall be filed by October 8, 1999.

5. Neither opening statements nor witnesses summaries of prefiled direct testimony will be permitted.

6. Pursuant to KRS 100.324, a copy of this Order is being sent to the Grant County Planning Commission for the purpose of notification that the above-scheduled hearing may affect locations or relocations of service facilities within the planning unit s jurisdiction.
