## <u>O R D E R</u>

On April 1, 1999, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) and Tipton Construction Company of Texas, Inc. d/b/a Advanced Communicating Techniques (Tipton) submitted to the Commission their negotiated agreement for resale of BellSouth's services to end-users. On April 19, 1999, BellSouth and Tipton submitted to the Commission an amendment to their resale agreement. The agreement was negotiated pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (1996 Act), 47 U.S.C. Sections 251 and 252. Section 252(e) of the 1996 Act requires the parties to an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation to submit the agreement for approval to the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the agreement and amendment and finds that no portion thereof discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement. The Commission also finds that the implementation of this agreement and amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

Tipton must comply with all relevant Commission mandates for serving in this Commonwealth.

The Commission, having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. The negotiated agreement and amendment between BellSouth and Tipton are approved.
- 2. Tipton shall file a tariff for local service prior to providing local service giving 30 days' notice to the Commission and shall comply with all Commission regulations and orders as directed.
