2. Warsaw shall file no later than September 27, 1999 with the Commission the original and 6 copies of the information listed in Appendix B of the Order of August 6, 1999.

3. The procedural schedule set forth in the Order of August 6, 1999 is modified to reflect the schedule set forth in Appendix A to this Order.
