On June 11, 1999, Meade County Water District (Meade District) submitted an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a new headquarters building in Brandenburg, Kentucky. On September 30, 1999, the Commission, through its Executive Director, advised Meade District that its application was deficient and requested that the deficiencies be cured no later than October 27, 1999. As of this date, Meade District has taken no action to cure the deficiencies. Accordingly, the Commission finds that the case should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is dismissed without prejudice, and is hereby removed from the Commission s docket.
