ORDER

On July 27, 1999, Christian County Water District (Christian Water) applied to the Commission for approval of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a waterworks improvement project and for approval of financing for said project. In its filing, Christian Water requested permission to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11(2)(c) and Sections 6(1) 6(9).

Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11(2)(c), requires the submission of detailed estimates by Uniform System of Accounts account numbers. Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, requires the submission of a detailed financial exhibit covering operations for a 12-month period ending not more than 90 days prior to the date of the application.

Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately Christian Water's filing. Therefore, its request for permission to deviate from the above-cited regulations should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Christian Water's request to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11(2)(c) and Sections 6(1)-6(9), is granted.
