<u>ORDER</u>

On November 19, 1999, Brandenburg Telephone Company ("Brandenburg") and Westel-Milwaukee Company, Inc. (WMC) submitted to the Commission their negotiated agreement for the interconnection of their networks. The agreement was negotiated pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (1996 Act), 47 U.S.C. Sections 251 and 252. Section 252(e) of the 1996 Act requires the parties to an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation to submit the agreement for approval to the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the agreement and finds that no portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement. The Commission also finds that the implementation of this agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

WMC must comply with all relevant Commission mandates for serving in this Commonwealth.

The Commission, having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The negotiated agreement between Brandenburg and WMC is approved.

2. WMC shall file a tariff for local service which contains terms and conditions for services, giving 30 days' notice to the Commission, and shall comply with all Commission regulations and orders as directed.
