O R D E R

On November 23, 1993, the Commission issued an Order in this case requiring South Central Bell Telephone Company, now known as BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), to file updated demand and revenue forecasts for services used to provide Memory Call service.

On March 20, 2000, BellSouth filed the required information. BellSouth also requested relief from further filings based upon existing safeguards protecting ratepayers against subsidization and upon the latitude afforded BellSouth under its price regulation plan.

The Commission, having considered the motion and finding good cause, HEREBY ORDERS that the motion is granted.
