<u>ORDER</u>

On July 26, 1999, the Commission approved an interconnection agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and Hyperion Communications of Kentucky, Inc. ("Hyperion"). On January 14, 2000, BellSouth and Adelphia Business Solutions of Kentucky, Inc., formerly known as Hyperion, submitted to the Commission an amendment to their interconnection agreement. The agreement was negotiated pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("1996 Act"), 47 U.S.C. Sections 251 and 252. Section 252(e) of the 1996 Act requires the parties to an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation to submit the agreement for approval to the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the amendment and finds that no portion of the amendment discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement. The Commission also finds that the implementation of this amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission, having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the amendment is approved.
