<u>O R D E R</u>

On October 16, 2000, the Commission ordered that Holly Creek Production Corporation ("Holly Creek") refund \$23,674 to Bethany Christian Mission Center, Inc. ("Complainant") in compliance with its July 28, 1999 Order. The Commission specifically ordered that the payments commence immediately and that the entire amount be refunded by August 1, 2002. The Commission clearly stated that Holly Creek's initial payment must therefore be sufficient to void its arrearages.

On November 10, 2000, Complainant filed a motion alleging that Holly Creek has not complied with the Commission's Order. The motion of the Complainant contains a letter from the president of Holly Creek, which offers a rebate according to the plan submitted by Holly Creek on September 27, 1999. That plan was rejected in the Commission's Order of October 16, 2000, and Holly Creek was ordered to make an immediate payment sufficient to void its arrearages. The Commission, being sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

Holly Creek shall file a response to the motion of the Complainant within
days of the date of this Order, stating whether or not it is in compliance with the
Commission's Order requiring immediate commencement of payments.

2. Holly Creek shall state the amount of its initial payment and the amounts of its future refund payments calculated to refund the entire amount by August 1, 2002.
