ORDER

Finding that the Commission's Order of January 20, 2000 contained a typographical error, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, <u>nunc pro tunc</u>, that the first literal paragraph of that Order is amended to read as follows:

The city of Warsaw, Kentucky ("Warsaw") and Gallatin County Water District ("Gallatin District") have agreed upon a rate which Warsaw will charge for wholesale water service and submitted this Agreement to the Commission. This action follows Warsaw's application for an adjustment of its current wholesale rate, Gallatin District's objection to the proposed adjustment, and the initiation of this proceeding to investigate the proposed adjustment. Warsaw originally proposed a wholesale rate of \$1.50 per 1,000 gallons of water. The parties agreed to a wholesale rate of \$1.05 per 1,000 gallons of water.
