ORDER

On June 18, 1999, SBA Towers, Inc. and GTE Wireless of the Midwest Incorporated ("Joint Applicants") filed a uniform application requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct a tower on Skyway Drive, Williamstown, Grant County, Kentucky. On October 1, 1999, the Grant County Planning Commission (the "Planning Commission") filed a copy of the minutes of its public hearing in regard to the application, together with a letter stating that Joint Applicants had agreed to "indefinitely table" the application. The minutes submitted by the Planning Commission demonstrate Joint Applicants' plan to pursue a co-location opportunity that would render this application moot. However, to date, no further filings have been made in this case.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

Joint Applicants should file, within ten days from the date of this Order, a

status report showing cause, if any, why this case should not be dismissed from the

Commission's docket.

2. If, within ten days from the date of this Order, Joint Applicants have not

submitted a status report showing cause why this case should remain on the docket, the

case shall, without further Order herein, be dismissed without prejudice.
