O R D E R

This matter is before the Commission upon the motion of Intervenors, George Krauser, Jr. and Patricia Krauser, Don and Martha Edling, Leonard Gross, Barbara Ballard, Dr. Armond Gordon, Clara Bilharz, William and Thelma McGuirk, Mark and Mary Lee O'Bryan, Trudy York Miller, Patrice Rymarowitz, Clare Blackburn, Steven and Judy Spooner, Edward and Barbara Weilage, Raymond D. and Judy Rohmann, and Theodore and Ann H. Stewart, by Counsel Edwin Bornstein, to reschedule the hearing set on June 27, 28 and 29, 2000. Mr. Bornstein has had a commitment that has been scheduled for several months and that will cause him to be out of the state from June 28 through July 4, 2000. Because this case involves the Applicants' request that the

Commission override the rejection by the Louisville and Jefferson County Planning Commission of Applicants' proposal to construct an antenna tower, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted and that a prehearing conference should be set.

Being sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The Intervenors' motion to reschedule the hearing is granted.
2. A prehearing conference on the proposed wireless telecommunications facility is scheduled for June 27, 2000 at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.
3. At the prehearing conference, the hearing will be rescheduled to later dates consisting of three consecutive days.
