ORDER

This matter is before the Commission to set a new hearing date. On June 27, 2000, a prehearing conference was conducted by the hearing officer to establish a date for hearing and to establish the issues to be addressed by the parties at hearing. It was agreed by the parties, Commission Staff, and hearing officer that the public hearing could be set to begin on August 22, 2000 at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time in Hearing Room 1 at the Commission's offices. The public hearing shall continue on successive days as necessary to complete the case up to and including August 24, 2000.

Pursuant to KRS 278.650, the application herein was submitted to the Louisville and Jefferson County Planning Commission ("LJCPC"). The LJCPC rejected the application and proposal to construct an antenna tower. The Commission is being

asked, pursuant to KRS 278.650(2), to override the LJCPC's decision. It was agreed by

the parties, Commission Staff, and hearing officer that there were only two issues to be

addressed at public hearing: first, whether there is an acceptable alternative site upon

which to construct the antenna tower and, second, whether the public convenience and

necessity require the construction of the proposed tower.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The public hearing on the proposed wireless telecommunications facility is

scheduled to begin on August 22, 2000 at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing

Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, and

the hearing shall continue on successive days up to and including August 24, 2000.

2. Pursuant to KRS 278.650(2), the parties shall appear at hearing and

present testimony and evidence relating to two issues: first, whether there is an

acceptable alternative site and, second, whether the public convenience and necessity

require the proposed construction. The parties can present testimony and evidence

regarding the engineering design, location (alternative site only) and construction of the

proposed cell site, as well as the jurisdictional safety issues relating to the cell site. The

foregoing is the extent of the testimony and evidence to be received at public hearing

unless otherwise ordered by the hearing officer.
