<u>ORDER</u>

On August 5, 2000, Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC") filed a motion requesting the Commission to direct Kentucky Power Company d/b/a American Electric Power ("Kentucky Power") to more fully respond to two data requests propounded at the July 18, 2000 hearing. KIUC alleges that the responses filed by Kentucky Power on August 8, 2000 are insufficient in the following respects:

- 1. The response to Item No. 1 does not include a schedule of the total energy produced by Kentucky Power for the twelve months ended June 2000 and the percentages of that energy sold to retail customers versus energy sold to others; and
- 2. The response to Item No. 3 includes an adjustment for the cost of low NOx burners while the data requested did not include such an adjustment.

Based on a review of the motion and the transcript of the July 18, 2000 hearing, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power's responses to hearing data request Item Nos. 1 and 3 are insufficient and should be supplemented.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kentucky Power shall file, within 5 days of the date of this Order, a revised response to data request Item No. 1 to include for the

twelve months ended June 2000 the energy produced and to whom sold on a KWH

basis with percentages, and Item No. 3 to exclude the cost of low NOx burners.
