O R D E R

Ohio County Water District ("Ohio") has filed a motion with the Commission seeking a deviation from the requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, that it file with its application financial data prepared within 90 days prior to filing. Ohio states that its financial exhibits have been compiled for the 12-month period ending September 30, 1999 and that its reports thereof were completed on March 24, 2000.

After considering the motion, the Commission finds that:

1. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, the Commission may grant a deviation from this regulation for good cause.
2. The request of Ohio for a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, should be granted, because the utility would incur extraordinary expenses, as well as delay, in updating its financial records.

The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that Ohio is granted a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, and its financial filings are accepted for the purposes of meeting the filing requirements.
