O R D E R

On April 19, 2000, Mr. Mujahid Sheikh ("Complainant") filed a formal complaint alleging that MCI WorldCom ("MCI") offered him 350 minutes of free international calling each month for six months and then refused to provide the promised credit on those calls. MCI responded to the Commission's Order to Satisfy or Answer the complaint on May 19, 2000. In its Answer Showing Satisfaction, MCI disputes that any such offer was made. However, it has canceled the outstanding debt owed on Complainant's account. To date, Complainant has filed no response to MCI's Answer Showing Satisfaction.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(5), MCI has satisfied the complaint. Accordingly, no further proceedings in this docket are necessary.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and having been sufficiently advised, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the complaint be, and it hereby is, dismissed.
