¹ Louise J. Lear is being granted intervention individually. Ms. Lear's letter stated that she wished to intervene on behalf of Green Sentinel Farm, Inc. ("Green Sentinel"). However, if Green Sentinel wishes to intervene, it must be represented by a licensed attorney. Representation of the rights of others before an administrative agency is considered the practice of law and must be performed by a licensed attorney. Kentucky Bar Association v. Henry Vogt Machine Co., 416 S.W.2d 727 (Ky. 1967).

3. Should Ms. Lear file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, she shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
