## FIRST DATA REQUEST OF COMMISSION STAFF TO CUMBERLAND VALLEY ELECTRIC, INC.

Cumberland Valley Electric, Inc. ("Cumberland"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and eight copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before November 20, 2000. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. Where information herein has been previously provided, in the format requested herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request.

1. Refer to Exhibit 2, page 2 of 4 of Cumberland's application.

a. Provide the source for the determination of the number of minutes required and mileage required in calculating the miscellaneous charges. Provide a detailed explanation and workpapers needed to support the calculations.

b. Explain the difference in mileage required in the overtime charge of\$9.30 and the rest of the miscellaneous charges at \$4.65.

c. Provide the computation used in obtaining the \$.31 mileage rate.

2. Refer to Exhibit 2, page 3 of 4 of Cumberland's application.

a. Provide the source and the calculation used for the average cost of anchors of \$44.82.

b. Provide the computation for the annual carrying charges of 19.46 percent.

3. Provide the computation involved in arriving at each attachment charge given in Item B. Discuss how each factor in the computation was calculated other than those factors already provided in Item 2(a) and 2(b) above.
